Appendix on Training and Credentials May 2021.

1. Some provision has been approved by the Board for the possibility of remote supervision while transport restrictions due to the pandemic are in force. These apply only to active supervised residents.
EVDC Equine residents that have suspended their programme but wish to accredit in 2021 must upload any revised application for Approval of a new centre to DMS advising of their new centre for approval, co-signed by supervisor and detailing new programme for their supervision by July 1st 2021. The EdCom will review these within at least 1 month enabling the programme to recommence from 1st July if they are uploaded in timely fashion. Applications uploaded later (by 1st December 2021) will be reviewed in time to recommence the programme the following January. (This is in addition to annual submissions for the year 2020-21)
2. If residents who have suspended their training wish to resume their residency training in 2022 these documents must be submitted by 1st December 2021.
